Suffolk Coast and Heath AONB.

Staff and workload commitments meant that only superficial review of the plan took place and it was given tacit support.

Anglian Water

Two suggestions for modifications to policies/strategies. Both agreed.

Environment Agency.

Unable to provide bespoke comments on the Neighbourhood Plan, but included generic guidance documents.

Historic England.

Have asked for a time extension until November 25th which was agreed.

Natural England

P. Coshut

Declined to make specific comments on the details of the Plan, but concluded that it was unlikely to have any adverse effects on the natural environment, including designated sites and landscapes.

Suffolk County Council

Archaeology.

No action. Responsibility of SCDC at planning application stage.

Natural Environment.

- 1. Agreed that BNo would review Chapter 11 and Policies P11 to P15 with a view to incorporating SCC ideas.
- 2. Also to consider deleting Policy 16 and include content in the preamble and to amalgamate Policy 4 and Policy 17.
- 3. As regards Assessment Requirements we have taken the view from Natural England and SCDC submission that this is not necessary, but will investigate further.

Agreed to use the Independent Observation schedule drawn up for the first consultation to make judgements about responses.

Public Responses.

- 1. Noted that there was at least a 75% approval rating and an average of about 90% for all policies and strategies. Consistent points raised were addressed as follows.
- 2. Policy 2. The use of the word necessity comes from the Local plan.
- 3. Policy 3. Reword as ... built up frontage including terraces.

P. Corbet

- 4. Policy 4. Exceptional circumstances would mean meeting all criteria laid out in the NPPF, Local Plan and neighbourhood Plan policies.
- 5. Strategy 4. PJN Motors to be added. Supported is interpreted as meaning that the Parish Council would assist expansion of these facilities where possible and within the remit of the Neighbourhood Plan.
- 6. Strategy 23. Other health centres to be added.
- 7. Strategy 27 and elsewhere. The word ADVERSE to be changed to SIGNIFICANT.
- 8. Strategy 30. Consult land owners about adding boot scraper, water pump and The Star to the list.
- 9. Comments from parishioner JD not agreed with because of definition of LDPA and comments from SCDC about them.
- 10. Star Hill footpath. Include in SCC discussion.
- 11. Blyth Wood. Not land use, so not included

Response from Southwold Railway Trust.

Agreed that SRT was a single interest group promoting restoration of a railway. Land owned by SRT in the parish is grazing marshland and planning permission has been refused and appeals lost for developing this site. In this respect, it was agreed that the land would be perceived as grazing marshland outside the physical limits boundary. Agreed that Neighbourhood Plan consultations are conducted on democratic and consensus principles and could not be used to promote the aims of the SRT or any other single interest groups.

Agreed to include two passages in the History section broadly as follows and subject to verification.

The Blyth Navigation system was built in 1761 and is the second oldest in the UK. and provided Wenhaston with access to goods by water.

A narrow gauge railway existed in Wenhaston from 1879 to 1929 and was used for passengers and freight on the eight mile journey from Halesworth to Southwold.
